The Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing/certifying, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including certified nursing assistants in the State of Oregon. Leroy Todd Hall (Certificate Holder) is a certified nursing assistant in Oregon.

The Oregon State Board of Nursing considered this matter on May 25, 2011. Certificate Holder did not appear personally.

On April 26, 2011, the Board properly served notice on Certificate Holder that it intended to revoke Certificate Holder's nursing assistant certificate for conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant. The Notice offered to Certificate Holder an opportunity for hearing, if requested within the 20 days of mailing of the Notice. The Notice designated the relevant portions of the Board's file on this matter, including all materials submitted by Certificate Holder as the record for purposes of default.

FINDINGS OF FACT**

Based on the evidence submitted through the Notice and the agency file in this case, the Board finds the following:

- 1.1 In July 2010, Certificate Holder accepted a loan of \$670.00 from a client for Certificate Holder's personal use.
- 1.2 In October 2010, Certificate Holder accepted another loan from the same client for \$200.00 for his personal use.
- 1.3 Certificate Holder failed to pay back the entire sum owed to his client until the facility terminated Certificate Holder on October 21, 2010.
- 1.4 On April 20, 2011, the Oregon State Board of Nursing suspended Certificate Holder's nursing assistant certificate for failure to cooperate during the course of the Board investigation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of fact, the Board makes the following Conclusions of Law:

- 2.1 That the Board has jurisdiction over Certificate Holder, and over the subject matter of this proceeding.
- 2.2 That Certificate Holder's conduct constitutes a grave danger to public health and safety, and by the above actions is subject to discipline pursuant to violations of ORS 678.442 (2) (f); OAR 851-063-0080 (6); 851-063-0090 (1) (c); (2) (g); (9) (a) and (c).
- 2.3 That Certificate Holder defaulted on the Notice by not requesting a hearing by, May 17, 2011, and as a result, pursuant to ORS 183.310 to 183.750, the Board may enter a Final Order by default.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and the Board being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Oregon nursing assistant certificate of Leroy Todd Hall is revoked.
