The Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including CNAs. John Bott (Certificate Holder) was issued a Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate by the Board on January 22, 2003.

In July 2014, the Board received a renewal application on which Certificate Holder failed to disclose a recent arrest for Assault in the Fourth Degree, Interfering with a Peace Officer, and other related charges. The Board opened an investigation into the matter.

In November 2014, Certificate Holder underwent a chemical dependency assessment where he was diagnosed with Alcohol Dependence. Licensee engaged in outpatient treatment.

On January 14, 2015, the Board approved of a signed Stipulated Order for Probation of the Certificate Holder for a period of 24 months of probation.

Licensee was contacted by mail January 20, 2015 to call and arrange for an initial interview with the probation compliance specialist. On February 11, 15 Certificate Holder called and indicated he was thinking of letting his certificate go. On February 18, 2015 Certificate Holder confirmed he wished to voluntarily surrender his Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate.

By the above actions, Licensee is subject to discipline pursuant to:

ORS 678.442 Certification of nursing assistants; rules.

(2) In the manner prescribed in ORS chapter 183, the board may revoke or suspend a certificate issued under this section or may reprimand a nursing assistant for the following reasons:

(f) Conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant in the performance of duties.

OAR 851-063-0090 Conduct Unbecoming a Nursing Assistant

(10) Conduct related to the certification holder's relationship with the Board:

(d) Violating the terms and conditions of a Board order.

Licensee wishes to cooperate with the Board in this matter and voluntarily surrender his Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate.

Therefore, the following will be proposed to the Oregon State Board of Nursing and is agreed to by Licensee:

That the voluntary surrender of the Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate of John Bott be accepted. If, after a minimum of three years, Mr. Bott wishes to reinstate his CNA license, he may submit an application to the Board to request reinstatement.

Certificate Holder agrees that he will not practice as a CNA from the date he signs this Order.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order will be submitted to the Board of Nursing for its approval and is subject to the Board's confirmation.

Certificate Holder understands that by signing this Stipulated Order, he waives the right to an administrative hearing under ORS 183.310 to 183.540, and to any judicial review or appeal thereof. Licensee acknowledges that no promises, representations, duress or coercion have been used to induce him to sign this Order.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order is a document of public record.

Certificate Holder has read this Stipulated Order, understands this Order completely, and freely signs this Stipulated Order for Voluntary Surrender.
