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The Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including Certified Nursing Assistants. Gregory Taibi (Certificate Holder) was issued a Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate by the Board on February 20, 2014.

This matter was considered by the Board at its meeting on March 18, 2015.

On February 20, 2015, a Notice stating that the Board intended to Revoke the Certified Nursing Assistant certificate of Gregory Taibi was sent to him via certified and first-class mail to his address of record. The Notice alleged that Licensee was in violation of a signed Stipulated Order for Probation.

The Notice granted Licensee an opportunity for hearing if requested within twenty (20) days of the mailing of the Notice. No such request for hearing has been received by the Board. The Notice designated the Board's file on this matter as the record for purposes of default.

NOW THEREFORE, after consideration of its records and files related to this matter, the Board enters the following Order:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

Based on the evidence submitted through the Notice and the agency file in this case, the Board finds the following:

1. On February 20, 2014, the Board issued a Certified Nurse Assistant Certificate for Taibi.
2. On September 25, 2014, the Board accepted a signed Stipulated Order for Probation to address charges for menacing, and subsequent diagnosis for alcohol dependence.
3. On January 20, 2015 the compliance specialist received the initial Status Report from Choices Counseling Center which indicated client was currently attending treatment as mandated by the Court. It is also noted that licensee tested positive on 11/25/14 and 1/6/15 for Marijuana.

4. On January 22, 2015, a letter was sent regular and certified mail to Taibi requesting a written explanation to the Board regarding the two positive toxicology results. Taibi was requested in this letter to resume testing with the Board's laboratory. Taibi did not resume testing with the Board's vendor, Phamatech.
5. On February 18, 2015, the Board voted to issue a Notice of Proposed Revocation. A notice was sent on February 20, 2015, to Taibi via first-class and certified mail. The Notice granted Taibi twenty (20) days from the date of the mailing of the Notice to request a hearing. The Notice also designated that the agency file would be the record for purposes of default.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. That the Board has jurisdiction over the Licensee, Gregory Taibi, and over the subject matter of this proceeding.
2. That Licensee's conduct is in violation of a signed Stipulated Order for Probation.
3. That Licensee defaulted on the Notice by not requesting a hearing within the allotted twenty (20) days and, as a result, pursuant to ORS 183.417(3), the Board may enter a Final Order by Default.

### **ORDER**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and the Board being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Certified Nursing Assistant certificate of Gregory Taibi is Revoked.

TO: GREGORY TAIBI:

You may file a petition for reconsideration or rehearing of this Order. Reconsideration or rehearing may be obtained by filing a petition with the Board of Nursing within (sixty) 60 days from the service of this Order. Your petition shall set forth the specific grounds for reconsideration. Reconsideration or rehearing is pursuant to the provisions in ORS 183.482.

As an alternative to filing a Petition for Reconsideration of this Order, you are entitled to judicial review of this Order. Judicial review may be obtained by filing a petition with the Oregon Court of Appeals for review within sixty (60) days from the date of service of this Order. Judicial review is pursuant to the provisions of ORS 183.482.

**INCLUDE ONLY IF FOR REVOCATION:** If, after a minimum of three (3) years, you wish to reinstate your Certified Nursing Assistant License/certificate, you may submit an application to the Board to request reinstatement.
