Aleksandr Voloshin (CNA) was issued a Certified Nursing Assistant certificate by the Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) on April 26, 2004.

On or about September 26, 2011, the Board received information that disclosed an arrest history for DUII and other misdemeanor charges.

On July 18, 2012, the Board placed Certificate Holder on 24 months of Probation.

Certificate Holder has been in compliance with his Board order but unable to secure employment. He does not have the practice hours to renew his certificate when it expires on September 22, 2013. He has chosen to voluntarily surrender his certificate at this time to follow a different career path.

By the above actions, CNA is subject to discipline pursuant to violations of ORS 678.442 (2) (c) and OAR 851-063-0090 (7) (9) (d).

ORS 678.442 Certification of nursing assistant's rules

(2) In the manner prescribed in ORS 183.310-183.550, the Board may revoke or suspend a certificate

issued under this section or may reprimand a nursing assistant for the following reasons:

(c) Use of any controlled substance or intoxicating liquor to an extent or in a manner dangerous or

injurious to the certificate holder or others or to an extent that such use impairs the ability to conduct

safely the duties as a nursing assistant.

OAR 851-063-0090 Conduct Unbecoming a Nursing Assistant

A CNA, regardless of job location, responsibilities, or use of the title "CNA," who, in the performance of nursing related duties, may adversely affect the health, safety or welfare of the public, may be found

guilty of conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant. Conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant includes,

but is not limited to:

(7) Conduct related to impaired function

(9) Conduct related to the Certificate Holder's relationship with the Board

(d) Violating the terms and conditions of a Board order.

CNA wishes to cooperate with the Board in this matter and voluntarily surrender his Certified Nursing Assistant certificate.

Therefore, the following will be proposed to the Oregon State Board of Nursing and is agreed to by CNA:

That the voluntary surrender of the Certified Nursing Assistant certificate of Aleksandr Voloshin be accepted. If, after a minimum of three years, Mr. Voloshin wishes to reinstate his Certified Nursing Assistant certificate, he may submit an application to the Board to request reinstatement.

CNA agrees that he will not practice as a Certified Nursing Assistant from the date he signs this Order.

CNA understands that this Order will be submitted to the Board of Nursing for its approval and is subject to the Board's confirmation.

CNA understands that by signing this Stipulated Order, he waives the right to an administrative hearing under ORS 183.310 to 183.540. CNA acknowledges that no promises, representations, duress or coercion have been used to induce him to sign this Order.

CNA understands that this Order is a document of public record.

CNA has read this Stipulated Order, understands this Order completely, and freely signs this Stipulated Order for Voluntary Surrender.
