The Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including Certified Nursing Assistants. Alyse Lundbom (Certificate Holder) was issued a Certified Nursing Assistant certificate by the Board on July 3, 2006.

On or about August 11, 2014, the Board received information that Certificate Holder had disclosed her history of drug use while seeking approval from the Department of Human Services to work in an adult foster home. The Board opened an investigation into the matter.

Certificate Holder reported she had abused an illegal drug for a number of years. In April 2014, Certificate Holder entered a chemical dependency treatment program. Certificate Holder did not successfully complete her recommended treatment. Certificate Holder stopped participating in treatment in July 2014.

In an investigative interview with Board staff, Certificate Holder stated she has remained clean and sober since mid-July 2014. Certificate Holder stated she does not anticipate working as a nursing assistant in the future and plans to pursue a different career in healthcare going forward.

By the above actions, Certificate Holder is subject to discipline pursuant to ORS 678.442(2)(f) and OAR 851-063-0090(2)(h) & (7)(a), which provide as follows:

ORS 678.442 Certification of nursing assistants; rules.

- (2) In the manner prescribed in ORS chapter 183, the board may revoke or suspend a certificate issued under this section or may reprimand a nursing assistant for the following reasons:
 - (f) Conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant in the performance of duties.

OAR 851-063-0090 Conduct Unbecoming a Nursing Assistant

A CNA, regardless of job location, responsibilities, or use of the title "CNA," who, in the performance of nursing related duties, may adversely affect the health, safety or welfare of the public, may be found guilty of conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant. Conduct unbecoming a nursing assistant includes but is not limited to:

- (2) Conduct related to other federal or state statutes/rule violations:
 - (h) Possessing, obtaining, attempting to obtain, furnishing or administering prescription or controlled drugs to any person, including self, except as directed by a person authorized by law to prescribe drugs.
- (7) Conduct related to impaired function:
 - (a) Use of drugs, alcohol or mind-altering substances to an extent or in a manner dangerous or injurious to the nursing assistant or others or to an extent that such

use impairs the ability to conduct safely the duties of a nursing assistant.

Certificate Holder wishes to cooperate with the Board in this matter and voluntarily surrender her Certified Nursing Assistant certificate.

Therefore, the following will be proposed to the Oregon State Board of Nursing and is agreed to by Certificate Holder:

That the voluntary surrender of the Certified Nursing Assistant certificate of Alyse Lundbom be accepted. If, after a minimum of three years, Ms. Lundbom wishes to reinstate her Certified Nursing Assistant certificate, she may submit an application to the Board to request reinstatement.

Certificate Holder agrees that she will not practice as a Certified Nursing Assistant from the date she signs this Order.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order will be submitted to the Board of Nursing for its approval and is subject to the Board's confirmation.

Certificate Holder understands that by signing this Stipulated Order, she waives the right to an administrative hearing under ORS 183.310 to 183.540, and to any judicial review or appeal thereof. Certificate Holder acknowledges that no promises, representations, duress or coercion have been used to induce her to sign this Order.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order is a document of public record.

Certificate Holder has read this Stipulated Order, understands this Order completely, and freely signs this Stipulated Order for Voluntary Surrender.
