The Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including Certified Nursing Assistants and Certified Medication Aides. Lanny Smith (Certificate Holder) was issued a Certified Nursing Assistant Certificate by the Board on September 11, 2014 and a Certified Medication Aide Certificate by the Board on April 30, 2015.

On or about June 26, 2017, the Board received a complaint alleging that on June 23, 2017, Certificate Holder, while being observed preparing and administering medications, failed to do so in a safe manner.

It was reported that several medications were found in labeled cups atop and inside the medication cart. When questioned, Certificate Holder acknowledged preparing her medication pass by pre-pouring medications and placing them in cups she labeled with the clients' names.

Certificate Holder also acknowledged that some of medications in the cups were remaining from the morning medication pass and some were in preparation for the mid-day pass.

Upon further review, it was noted that the Medication Administration Record (MAR) and the narcotic log were not accurate, as some of the medications (including narcotics) found in the cups, were documented by Certificate Holder as administered.

By the above actions, Certificate Holder is subject to discipline pursuant to OAR 851-063-0100 (1), (2) and (11), which provide as follows:

OAR 851-063-0100

Conduct Unbecoming a Certified Medication Aide

A certified medication aide is subject to discipline as described in these rules. In addition, a CMA is subject to discipline for conduct unbecoming a medication aide. Such conduct includes but is not limited to:

- (1) Failing to administer medications as ordered by a LIP;
- (2) Failing to document medications as administered, medications withheld or refused and the reason a medication was withheld or refused.
- (11) Failing to conform to the standards and authorized duties in these rules.

Certificate Holder wishes to cooperate with the Board in this matter. Therefore, the following will be proposed to the Oregon State Board of Nursing and is agreed to by her:

**That the Certified Medication Aide certificate of Lanny Smith be reprimanded.**

Certificate Holder understands that the conduct resulting in the violations of law described in this Order are considered by the Board to be of a grave nature and, if continued, constitutes a serious danger to public health and safety.

Certificate Holder understands that in the event she engages in future conduct resulting in violations of law or the Nurse Practice Act, the Board may take further disciplinary action against her certificate, up to and including revocation of her certificate to practice as a Certified Medication Aide.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order will be submitted to the Board of Nursing for its approval and is subject to the Board's confirmation.

Certificate Holder understands that by signing this Stipulated Order, she waives the right to an administrative hearing under ORS 183.310 to 183.540, and to any judicial review or appeal thereof. Certificate Holder acknowledges that no promises, representations, duress or coercion have been used to induce her to sign this Order.

Certificate Holder understands that this Order is a document of public record.

Certificate Holder has read this Stipulated Order, understands this Order completely, and freely signs this Stipulated Order for Reprimand.
